SC sets 3-month deadline for Telangana Speaker to decide on 10 BRS MLAs' disqualification

Oppn party welcomes verdict, attacks Rahul; Cong hits back

/ The Supreme Court on Thursday directed the Assembly Telangana Speaker to decide within months disqualification petitions against 10 BRS MLAs who had switched allegiance to the ruling Congress, saying political defections have the power to disrupt democracy if not curbed. The apex court held that the Speaker acts as a tribunal while deciding the pleas for disqualification under the Tenth Schedule of the Constitution and consequently does not "constitutional immunity" against judicial scrutiny. The Tenth the Schedule Constitution deals with provisions on disqualification on the grounds of defection. Asking the Speaker to decide the disqualification pleas within three months,

NAGAR (GUJARAT), JULY 31 /--/ Five out of the total 30 gates of the Sardar Sarovar Dam at Ekta Nagar in Gujarat have been opened to maintain the level of water after a huge inflow from the upstream region, officials said. This is for the first time that the gates of the Sardar Sarovar Dam were opened in this monsoon season. In an official statement, the Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Ltd (SSNNL) said five out of the total 30 gates of the dam were opened up to a height of two meters at 11 am on Thursday after the dam's water level increased by 2.71 centimetres in 24 hours. The inflow of water is mainly due to the rainfall in the upstream catchment area in the Narmada basin and the release of water from Omkareshwar dam in Madhya neighbouring Pradesh, it said. At present, the dam, situated near the Statue of Unity in Narmada district, is receiving a 4.22 lakh cusec (cubic feet per second) water while nearly 85,000 cusecs of water is being released into the river by opening five gates, the

"Though we do not possess any advisory jurisdiction, it is for Parliament to consider whether the mechanism of entrusting the Speaker/ Chairman the important task of deciding the issue of disqualification on the grounds of defection is serving the purpose of effectively combating political defections or not,"

"If the very foundation of our democracy and the principles that sustain it are to be safeguarded, it is to be examined whether the present mechanism is sufficient or not. At the cost of repetition, we observe that it is for Parliament to

verdict said. It allowed appeals filed by Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leaders, including Padi Kaushik Reddy seeking a direction to the speaker to expeditiously decide disqualification petitions against the defected MLAs.

The bench set aside the November 22, 2024 decision of the Telangana High Court's division bench which had interfered with a prior order of a single judge. "We have referred to various parliamentary speeches, including those by Rajesh Pilot and Devendra Nath Munshi, to emphasise that entrusting disqualification proceedings to the speaker were aimed at avoiding delays that may occur before courts," it said. The judgement asked the Speaker not to allow the MLAs to prolong the disqualification proceedings. It also asked the speaker to draw adverse inferences if the MLAs protracted proceedings. The verdict, however, rejected the submissions that the apex court itself disqualification petitions, referring to some earlier judgements. It also noted defection that the Speaker did not even issue notice on the disqualification petitions for nearly seven months. Court's decision. 21-year-old properly, Kamleshwari Pradhan claimed, adding her family has been following Christianity for the last four-five years. The tribal woman, whose parents are farmers, also claimed the two nuns and another person arrested in the case were innocent and said they should be released from jail. However, Bajrang Dal Durg unit convener Ravi Nigam denied all the allegations. "We have neither threatened nor beaten anyone. There are CCTV cameras installed at the railway station, the truth will come out through them," Pradhan said. Nuns Preethi Mary and Vandana Francis, both from Kerala, along with Sukhman Mandavi were arrested by the Government Railway Police (GRP) at Durg railway station in the state on July 25 following a complaint by a local Bajrang Dal functionary, who accused them of forcibly converting three women from the tribaldominated Narayanpur district and trafficking them.

Talking to news agency PTI at her village Kukrajhor in Abujhmad area of Narayanpur, Pradhan claimed she was not being trafficked as she was going along with them at her own will and with her parents consent.

"I was going to Agra with the nuns with the consent of my parents. From there, we were about to go to Bhopal where we were to be given work at a Christian hospital. We were promised Rs 10,000 salary per month along with food, clothes and accommodation," she said. Pradhan recounted that she, Mandavi and two other criticising the move. Pradhan, who has studied up to class 10, said she was working as a daily wage labourer and used to cycle around 10 km daily to reach the Narayanpur district headquarters to earn Rs 250 per day "Sukhman Mandavi, who told me about the job, is like a brother to me. We met through the church. Earlier, several women from the area had also gone to work in hospitals. Even a sister of Sukhman had worked outside in a Christian hospital and she later returned," she said.

Rejecting the allegations of conversion, she said: "My family has been following Christianity since the last four-five years My mother used to remain ill. We took them to 'changai' sabha (healing meeting), since then she started recovering, after which we started following the faith." Pradhan claimed the two Catholic nuns and Mandavi were innocent and appealed to the state government to release them.
